



2009 Summer Field Camp III

The EMRG-E GK12 Summer Science Internship Program was created by Juliana Mederios in 2007. This program was originally intended to give students the opportunity to experience the scientific process up close. Students from each of the three schools serviced by our GK12 program were given the opportunity to write an application stating why they would like to get this internship. During the week long science camp students have participated in ongoing research projects, participated in various field techniques, and collected data for ongoing field surveys. This summer for the first time we will invite back students that had participated in past camps. These students will be asked to choose one of the ongoing research projects to fully participate in. At the end of the week the returning students will be asked to give a short presentation to the parents and other attendees about their experience. First time attendees, as in past years, will have a schedule of various activities that they will do. Some of these are pitfall trapping of insects, geology hikes, vegetation surveys, mammal trapping, climate and weather, and astronomy. The Camp has space to up to 14 students to attend. Deadline for application is May 30, 2009.
